FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view of the robot shown in FIG. 1.

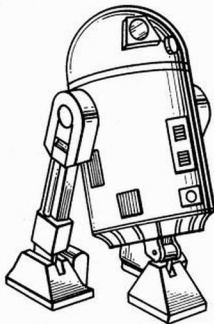

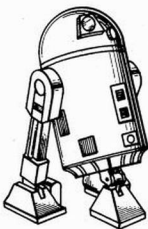
