

Thank you for purchasing the RadioShack Learn 'N' Fun Robot. It is an interactive educational toy designed for children, age 3 and above. The robot can help your child learn numbers, colors, and shapes. It can also help your child develop listening skills.

INSTALLING BATTERIES

Your robot requires 4 AA batteries (not supplied) for power. For the best performance and longest life, we recommend RadioShack alkaline batteries.

- Use a Phillips screwdriver to remove the battery compartment cover's screw (located on the back of the robot). Then remove the cover.
- Place four batteries in the compartment according to the polarity symbols (+ and -) marked inside.
- 3. Replace the cover and secure it with the screw.

When the robot's voice weakens or it stops operating properly, replace the batteries.

OPERATION

PLAYING NUMBERS

Slide 123/OFF/AD to 123. The robot plays music and says "Hello! Let's play together!". The robot's eyes remain lit after briefly flashing. V

Press a number button to hear the button's number. For example, when you press 1, you hear "This is the number one."

PLAYING COLORS AND SHAPES

Slide 123/OFF/AD to AD. The robot plays music and says "Hello! Let's play together!". The robot's eyes remain lit after briefly flashing.

Press a number button to hear the button's color and shape. For example, press 1, you hear "This is the blue circle."

MOVEMENT

Your robot moves in three preprogrammed patterns.

Slide 123/OFF/ to 123 or . The robot plays music and says "Hello! Let's play together!". The robot's eyes remain lit after briefly flashing.

Press \mathcal{G} , S, or \mathcal{G} . The robot moves in the pre-programmed pattern and its eyes flash.

PLAYING MELODIES

Your robot plays 11 different melodies.

- 2. Battle Hymn of the Republic
- 3. Pop Goes the Weasel
- 4. Away in a Manger
- 5. Mary Had a Little Lamb

- 7. Little Brown Jug
- 8. She'll Be Coming Round the Mountain
- 9. Twinkle Twinkle Little Star
- 10. Santa Lucia
- 11. Foster's Melody

If you press more than eleven times, the robot subtracts "11" and then plays the song that equals the number of difference. For example, if you press 14 times (14-11=3), the robot plays the third melody "Pop Goes the Weasel.".

Slide 123/OFF/ Ω to 123 or Ω . The robot plays music and says "Hello! Let's play together!". The robot's eyes remain lit after briefly flashing.

Press to play the first melody. The robot's eyes flash while the melody plays. To play the 2nd to 11th melody, press the same number of times as the melody you want to hear. [Y

CARE

Keep the robot dry; if it gets wet, wipe it dry immediately. Use and store the robot only in normal temperature environments. Handle the robot carefully; do not drop it. Keep the robot away from dust and dirt, and wipe it with a damp cloth occasionally to keep it looking new.

If your robot is not performing as it should, take it to your local RadioShack store for assistance. Modifying or tampering with the robot's internal components can cause a malfunction and might invalidate its warranty.
